

#### ECMO candidate required information

## Clinical history

- age
- · functional status before critical illness
- · ventilator days
- organ failures (kidneys, heart, need for vasopressor, etc)
- any issues with receiving heparin (HIT, allergy, etc)

# Objective data

- · vital signs, including weight and height
- · vent settings and most recent ABG
- · key labs
  - active type & screen
  - hemoglobin (need >8 to cannulate)
  - platlet count (need >100 to cannulate)
  - INR, aPTT, fibrinogen if available

#### Logistics

- plan for cannulation and initiation (their surgeon [preferred] vs our surgeon)
- · what is current sedation/analgesia/paralysis
- IV access (central venous catheter or PICC required- need to have right IJ open)
- · inhaled Flolan or nitric oxide?
- number of IV pumps
- other equipment that would need to be transported (IABP, etc)
- required of outside hospital before transport back to HCMC
  - X-rays to confirm cannula placement
  - · two units PRBCs in cooler to accompany patient
